The 48th Annual New Market Days Festival will be held September 29 and 30, 2007. The festival begins at 10:00 each day and concludes at 5:0 pm. Step back in time and experience our 18th century heritage as the streets are lined with entertainers, historic characters, local artisans and shops, and regional cuisine. There will be something for everyone. Throughout the day on Saturday and Sunday visitors will experience reenactments and tour encampments on the grounds of the Grange Hall and Messanelle Park. With cannons booming and smoke rising from battlefield action visitors will be transported back in to time to the sights and

sounds of the past. Enjoy craft demonstrations throughout town by artisans who carry on the traditions of the candle makers, potters, basket makers, chair caners and more. Take in a show, listen to some music, participate in a fencing exhibition and grab something good to eat.

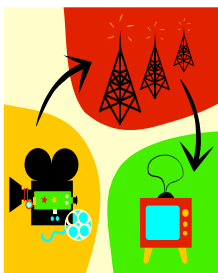
New Market Days Highlights
