Carts are the property of Frederick County Government and should remain at the house they are assigned to, even if residents move.

When placing carts out for curbside collection, they should be set no farther than 6 feet from the road and at least four feet away from any possible obstructions such as trees, cars or mailboxes. Carts should be placed with the wheels and handle towards the curb.

Recyclables should never be placed inside plastic bags for collection (except for bags of bags).

Following these guidelines makes the collection process safer and more efficient.

Collection will NOT take place on the following holidays:

- GOOD FRIDAY- 4/22
- MEMORIAL DAY- MONDAY, 5/30
- LABOR DAY- MONDAY, 9/5
- THANKSGIVING- THURSDAY, 11/24

After a holiday, the collection schedule for the remainder of the week shifts one day later than the usual day.

The more you know about recycling here in Frederick County, the easier it is. Here are some pointers.

YEP.

- Place shredded paper in a paper bag or cardboard box (even an old cereal box will do!)
- Put plastic grocery bags inside one bag
- Remove styrofoam from boxes
- Cart full? Put extra recyclables on curb in box or paper bag*
- Separate newspapers from plastic delivery bags
- Set out your cart with the wheels and handle towards the curb
- Remove plastic wraps from cardboard packaging
- Go to our new website to learn how you could win cash for recycling right!

*Upsize your cart on our website—for no cost!

NOPE.

- No need to cut down, bundle or compress cardboard
- Don't leave food or liquid in containers
- Don't take your cart with you if you move
- Never put mixed recyclables in any type of plastic bag
- Do not place your cart more than 6 feet from the curb
- Don't bag recyclables—they should be loose in the cart (except for shredded paper and bags of bags)



Your street's collection day is every other WEDNESDAY.
