The long awaited Streetscape project went to bid on August 4th. The notice to proceed will be issued sometime in October. There will be a Town Hall style meeting on Thursday, October 23rd at NMES. The time has yet to be decided, but will be posted on the Town website.

I wanted to thank Councilman Shane Rossman who has worked very hard on this project for since 2006. He has put together the entire record of the process, hosted many meetings allowing residents to express their wishes and concerns with respect to Streetscape. Councilman Rossman will continue to work on this project through its completion.

On May 26 the Smith-Cline and Delaplaine annexations became effective. Clean Water Linganore, Friends of Frederick County and RALE could not get the required signatures to force a referendum. I would like to thank all of you who supported the Town in this effort



especially all of you would invited us into your homes, hosted neighborhood meetings and helped get the word out. There are too many of you to single out in this newsletter, but we would like to express our gratitude to all of you for your effort. We could not have done this without you.

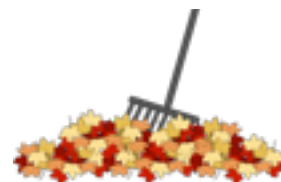

Snow & Ice Removal

Please remember that Main Street is designated a "Snow Emergency Route." During a snow event, please move your vehicle off Main Street to allow the plows to clear all the way to the curbs. You may park in the new community parking lot (next to the community park, Federal & South Alley) until Main Street has been plowed. The town has also arranged with the Grange Hall (located on South & Seventh Alley) to park in their lot.

Please clear off your sidewalks in front of your property within six (6) hours from the end of the snowfall or other precipitation, or if the snowfall or other precipitation occurred overnight, by 2:00 PM the following afternoon. If ice is not readily removable, sufficient calcium chloride or similar commercially available product should be applied to effectively melt and remove the accumulation of ice.

There is **NO FEE** to drop off materials. The event is for Frederick County residential waste only!

NO BUSINESSES.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS INCLUDE:

- Fluorescent Bulbs (compact & tube)
- Medicines (in original containers only)
- Fuels (gasoline/kerosene)
- Thinners and solvents
- Stains & sealants
- Pesticides/insecticides/fungicides
- Household cleaners
- Pool chemicals
- Mercury thermometers
- Photographic chemicals
- Nickel-cadmium and NIMH batteries
- Mothballs
- Smoke Detectors

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS*:

- Any paint
- Biohazard waste
- Explosives or fireworks
- Firearms or ammunition
- Fire extinguishers
- Freon tanks and cylinders
- Radioactive materials
- Regular trash
- Recyclable materials
- Tires
- Vehicle batteries
- Motor oil & antifreeze
- Smoke Detectors

Medicines must be in original containers so that they can be identified for proper disposal; personal identification (names, etc) may be marked out/removed.

THIS EVENT WILL BE HELD RAIN OR SHINE. Household Hazardous Waste Drop Off Events are held twice a year, in spring and fall, and accept specific materials listed above. Apply Now for Sustainable Communities Tax Credit Program

Owners of historic commercial properties take note: Now is the time to submit an application for a state income tax credit for renovating your historic structures in Maryland.

Fiscal year 2015 applications opened this week for [the Sustainable Communities Competitive Commercial Tax Credit](#) program, administered by the Maryland Historical Trust. Commercial property owners may receive a tax credit on 20 percent of eligible expenses up to \$3 million for substantial rehabilitation projects.

The commercial program is one of three Sustainable Communities Tax Credits that will be offered this year and next. Residential property owners can apply for credits through the Homeowner Tax Credit Program. In April, the Maryland General Assembly reauthorized the program for three years and expanded it to include a small commercial tax credit for modest rehabilitation projects such as new roofs and updated façades. MHT will review small commercial applications starting September 1 for projects beginning January 1, 2015.
