Infrastructure News



Work has been scheduled to repair the uneven concrete pavement joints on the sidewalks in the historic district during the week of September 17 through September 22, 2012. The work will be completed in one day. Residents along Main Street, who have concrete sidewalks, will receive “reminders” regarding

this work project prior to the initiation of the project.

Short-term and long-term solutions are being investigated to address the storm water runoff problems along Strawberry Alley. Town Council is currently awaiting the cost estimates associated with the recommended solutions. Discussions of the contracted Town engineer’s recommendations, and associated costs, will take place at upcoming Town Council meetings.

We plan to schedule the survey work on Marley Street during the second quarter of this fiscal year. The purpose of the survey is to design an additional lane of traffic on Marley Street, thereby changing Marley Street into a bi-directional thoroughfare.

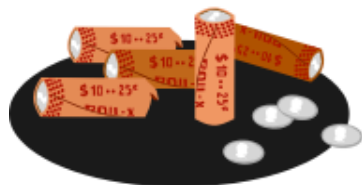
