Draft Memorandum of Understanding by and between Frederick County, Maryland, and the Town of New Market

The Draft Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) was passed for discussion. Mayor Burhans reported that more work is needed on the MOU.

The Nanny Mantz Center for Economic Development – proposal to use Old Town Hall, 39 West Main, as the Main Street Office/Visitor Center and Business Incubator

Ms. Moroney discussed the possibility of using Old Town Hall as a Main Street Office/Visitor Center and Business Incubator. Discussion ensued among the Council members and Ms. Moroney. Council provided the okay to Ms. Moroney to explore the idea.

LIAISON REPORTS

Mayor Burhans addressed some residents' concerns regarding the School Zone Speed Safety Program. Some issues included different addresses on the citation, where to send the payments, and that the Town does not have a Police Department. Through an MOU, we utilize the services of the police officers through the City of Frederick. Tommy Dommel, Program Administrator, School Zone Speed Safety Program released a Press Release addressing the concerns.

Councilman Wright discussed the renovation at Town Hall. He has received five (5) bids, all around \$7,000.00. By unanimous consent, if money is available in the budget, okay to proceed with the project.

Councilman Rossman was happy to announce that every light in Town was on. He inquired about the railing in front of 17 West Main Street. Antietam Metals was contracted to replace and is working on the repair. He followed-up with the residents in North Alley, and it appears that the work done in the alley is working in removing the rainwater.

Councilman Weatherly reported that he is working on a Green Team Resolution to present at the next Town Council meeting. He brought up the issue with the rubber matting by the basket swing at the Community Park to the Town's attention. He received a quote of around \$5,700. He will work with Deb Butler regarding budget funding and get it on the April agenda.
