Councilman Rossman reported that he sprayed weeds throughout the east end of Town. He also said that Lawson's was sent violation letters that were not picked up. Ms. Faux reported that she was going to post the violation letter on the door of the business.

Councilman Wright welcomed Councilman Kimble back. He provided an update on the work completed at 40 South Alley and 39 West Main Street. He reported that there was an issue with the bathroom at 40 South Alley and that he would repair it over the weekend.

Councilman Kimble discussed the various projects completed at 40 South Alley and 39 West Main Street, including a discussion on the gutters. He said that the ceiling of the women's public restroom needed to be fixed since the leak in the roof was repaired. He also discussed Messanelle Park. He mentioned that the boxwoods need to be replaced, and he would like to contact another nursey to draw up some new plans. Councilman Wright offered to work with Councilman Kimble to devise a plan for Messanelle Park.
